LOCATION: The Skylands at Randolph, 792 State Hwy. #10, Randolph, NJ

DIRECTIONS:

From South Jersey: Take either the Garden State Parkway or the N.J. Turnpike north to Route 287 north, approximately 1/2 hr. to Route 10 west (Exit 39). Continue west on Route 10 for 9.2 miles-Skylands is on the right.

From George Washington Bridge: Take Route 80 west approximately 1/2 hr. to Route 287 south exit. Continue on Route 287 south 3 mi. to Route 10 west (Exit 39). Continue west on Route 10 for 9.2 miles-Skylands is on the right.

From Goethals Bridge: Take the N.J. Turnpike north to Exit 14 (Newark Airport). Take Route 78 West to Route 24 West and continue until the end. Take Route 287 north one exit to Route 10 west (Exit 39). Continue west on Route 10 for 9.2 miles-Skylands is on the right.

From Northern Pennsylvania and Points West: Take Route 80 East to Exit 28, onto Route 10 East. Proceed approximately 5-1/4 mi. (7th traffic light) to the sign for Ironia/Dover-Chester Road. Make a right hand turn for the jug handle back to Route 10 West. Stay in the right hand lane passing the Dairy Queen, The Bethlehem Church and the Randolph Rescue Squad. Immediately after the rescue squad is the sign for The Skylands at Randolph. Make a right turn.

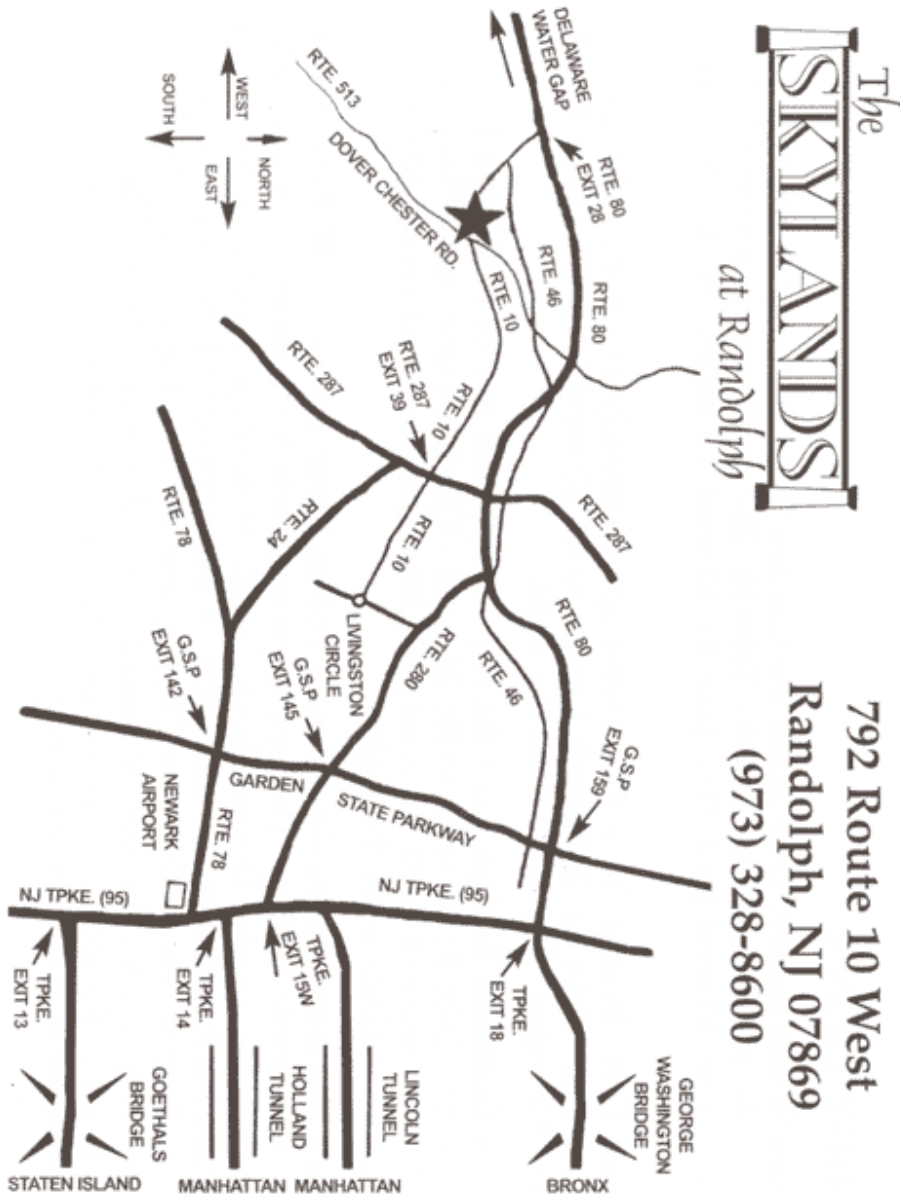
